### **Why do you need my date of birth?**

Your date of birth is currently used to set your authorisation expiry date, so that your card will expire on your birthday, and you won't arrive at the annual event that you authorised at to find that your card has expired.

### **Where did the waiver go?**

If you are at an event or practice in Australia, you already signed a waiver as a part of your membership, or when you signed in to the event. If you are at an event in New Zealand, you don't need to sign a waiver, but you do need to sign in to the event.
