### **Where did the waiver go?**

If you are at an event or practice in Australia, you already signed a waiver as a part of your membership, or when you signed in to the event. If you are at an event in New Zealand, you don't need to sign a waiver, but you do need to sign in to the event.

### **Privacy statement**

We collect your personal information in order to manage your authorisations for martial activities in the SCA.

Providing some information is optional, but if you choose not to provide your name and contact details, we'll be unable to provide you with an authorisation card, and you will be unable to participate in activities which require authorisation.

Your information is held in the Authorisations database that is maintained by the Lochac Masonry team, and can be accessed by approved marshals and lists officers in New Zealand and Australia.

You have the right to ask for a copy of any personal information we hold about you, and to ask for it to be corrected if you think it is wrong.
